## SCRIPTURE READING

### Selections from Exodus 35-36

Then Moses assembled the whole Israelite community and said to them, "This is what the Lord has commanded, "From what you have, bring an offering to construct a Tabernacle where my name might be praised. Let everyone who is willing, bring gold, silver, and bronze, blue, purple, and scarlet linens and yarns; leather and acacia wood. And let every person to whom I have given skills and abilities in construction, come and do the building, just as I will command you.""

Then all the Israelite men and women, who were willing, came and brought to the Lord, their freewill offerings, just as the Lord had commanded. Those who had been skilled by the Lord, began the physical work on the House of the Lord. As work progressed, morning after morning, the people continued to bring their freewill offerings to the Lord. One day, the skilled workers came to Moses and said, "The people are bringing more than enough to complete work on the House of the Lord."

Then Moses gave an order and sent it throughout the camp, "Stop all offerings for the sanctuary." And so the people were restrained for giving any more, because what they had given was more than enough to finish the Tabernacle of the Lord.
