MARK 11: 1-11. (The Message)

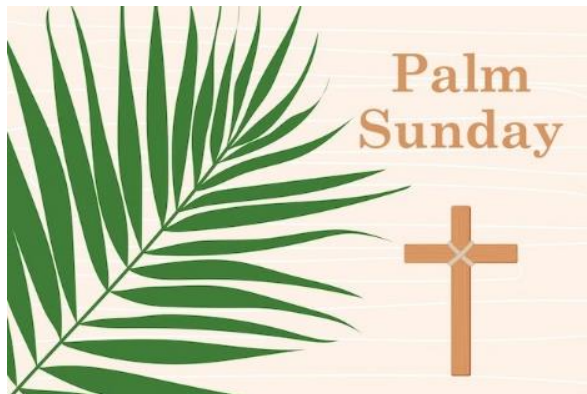
